## **SEXUAL ASSAULT CRISIS PROGRAMS REPORT**

The Governor's Office of Crime Control and Prevention is a part of the Executive Branch of State Government. The Governor's Office of Crime Control and Prevention's mission is to serve as the State Administering Agency in the application for, and administration of, federal and state funds for public safety, crime control and prevention; and to coordinate and promote public safety linkages and partnerships between and among federal, state and local agencies. During the 2011 Legislative Session, the Maryland Department of Human Resources proposed legislation to transfer the Domestic Violence and Rape Crisis/Sexual Assault Programs to the Governor's Office of Crime Control and Prevention. This transfer became effective July 1, 2011 through the passage of House Bill 739. The Sexual Assault Crisis Program is established by Criminal Procedure Article § 11-923(g) of the Annotated Code of Maryland.

The Maryland Rape Crisis Program is a statewide program funded through the State General funds and Sexual Assault Prevention funds from the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention. Services are provided through a network of community-based rape crisis programs and are available in every jurisdiction in Maryland. These programs provide comprehensive services to meet the specific needs of rape and sexual offense victims and family members affected by the abuse. Having these services available on a local level increases the likelihood that victims will avail themselves of the services and that there shall be appropriate linkages to other community-based services as needed. Additionally, provision of services and community education fosters a coordinated community approach to serving victims of rape and sexual assault that includes partnerships with law enforcement, courts, hospitals, local departments of social services and other related support agencies.


These funds are used to provide services to adult and child victims of rape and other sexual offenses. Services to victims include a 24-hour hotline, counseling, medical accompaniment, and assistance in accessing and using other support services such as legal assistance. Additionally, funds are designated for specific prevention efforts throughout the State. These efforts include presentations to community groups, pamphlets, and radio & television public service announcements. Currently, funds support 17 rape crisis programs that serve all 24 jurisdictions in Maryland. These programs consist of both private and non-profit agencies as well as governmental agencies.


### ***Data***\*

- In 2014, there were 1,144 forcible rapes reported. This represents a 2.1% decrease when compared to 2013; however, this figure still remains higher than 6 years ago. In this light, it is critical to address these issues and reduce rapes in all jurisdictions throughout the state.
- The most recent data states that there were 1,144 forcible rapes reported. Maryland's rapes and rape rate are decreasing at a slower pace when compared to other declining part 1 offenses. Recent data states that the three counties with the most rape reports were Baltimore City, Prince George's, and Montgomery County.

- Despite this, the most recent data states that Prince George’s County had the lowest rate of rape ever reported in that county. Montgomery County also had the lowest rate in 2012 ever reported there.
- Many of the counties who had experienced record low numbers of rapes in recent years, experienced a slight increase in 2014.
- Most recently in Maryland, out of all forcible rapes, 90% were rape by force and 10% were attempts to rape.
- A total of 351 persons were arrested for forcible rape in Maryland, according to the most recent data, with 13% juvenile, 59% Black, 40% White and 2% consisting of American Indian and Asian.





#### *Sexual Assault Forensic Examiners/Forensic Nurse Examiners Programs in Maryland*

In Maryland, Forensic Nurse Examiners work within a Sexual Assault Forensic Examiner program in a hospital to complete medical forensic examinations, treat victims for sexually transmitted infections, and address pregnancy concerns. When Forensic Nurse Examiners conduct an exam after a sexual assault, the evidence is collected with accuracy and precision. Sexual Assault Forensic Examiners Programs are coordinated by Registered Nurses, who are specifically trained and certified by the Maryland Board of Nursing. They care for victims of sexual assault, age 13 and above and collect forensic evidence to be submitted to the local Police Department Crime Lab. Forensic Nurse Examiners in the Sexual Assault Forensic Examiners Program conduct a complete evaluation of the victim and provide necessary services, including:

- Patient assessment
- Collection of forensic evidence and documentation of findings
- Antibiotic treatment to prevent transmission of sexually transmitted infections
- Emergency contraception
- Referrals to crisis counseling and other support services

Where they exist, Sexual Assault Forensic Examiners programs have made a profound difference in the quality of care provided to sexual assault victims. Forensic Nurse Examiners offer victims prompt, compassionate care and comprehensive forensic evidence collection. In addition to helping preserve the victim's dignity and reduce psychological trauma, Sexual Assault Forensic Examiners programs are enhancing evidence collection for a more effective

investigations and better prosecution. Particularly, in non-stranger sexual assaults, which are the majority of sex crimes, thorough documentation of evidence that helps to corroborate a victim's account of an assault by establishing lack of consent has led to more prosecutions that are successful.

### ***Maryland's Rape Crisis Centers***

Rape Crisis and Recovery Centers provide the following confidential services to adult and child victims as well as their families, partners, and loved ones:

- Crisis intervention, counseling, and referral.
- Victim accompaniment to hospitals, police interviews, and court to provide support and information about options.
- 24-hour Crisis Hotline with counselors trained to listen and offer information.
- Individual, group, and family psychotherapy.
- Assistance navigating the legal and judicial systems.

All crisis-intervention, referral, and accompaniment services are free. Clinical services are provided by specially trained psychologists, social workers, and paraprofessionals. No one is turned away due to inability to pay for services.

The following are three examples of Rape Crisis Intervention Services programs in Maryland. They are TurnAround, Inc. (Baltimore County), For All Seasons, Inc., and Heartly House, Inc. and are representative of the services provided to sexual assault victims and their families.

**TurnAround, Inc. (Baltimore County)** opened in 1978 and provided specialized trauma therapy. It expanded its services in 1981 to include the Emergency Room Victim Advocate program, and in 2011 it added a specialized program for sex trafficking. TurnAround, Inc. is the only organization that provides comprehensive services to survivors of rape, sexual assault/abuse and or sexual trafficking (sexual violence in Baltimore City and Baltimore County). TurnAround, Inc.'s Sexual Assault Services Program offers case management, advocacy, emergency housing, transitional housing, and trauma therapy to survivors. The program also provides community education.

During Fiscal Year 2015, TurnAround, Inc. provided the following sexual assault services resources:

- 375 survivors received services;
- 164 survivors received crisis intervention;
- 173 survivors were provided with medical accompaniment;
- 202 counseling sessions were provided to survivors of sexual assault; and
- 27 community education presentations were conducted on topics including sexual assault, healthy relationships, and child abuse prevention, reaching over 700 individuals.

**For All Seasons, Inc.** is a behavioral health and rape crisis center that serves the five counties of the Mid-Shore: Caroline, Dorchester, Kent, Queen Anne's, and Talbot. It provides

comprehensive services including a 24-hour hotline, advocacy, legal services, crisis intervention, therapy, case management, medical accompaniment, information and referrals, and community education.

For All Seasons, Inc. provides hotline services and medical accompaniment in both English and Spanish. When serving victims in the emergency department, the agency provides information regarding the rights of victims, the role of law enforcement, the process for accessing the criminal justice system, as well as services available at the agency. During Fiscal Year 2015, the agency provided approximately 50 medical accompaniment to victims of sexual assault, family members, and friends while they received medical care at emergency departments. Moreover, the agency coordinated meetings with the local State's Attorney's Office to meet with victims and provide advocacy, support, and interpretation services.

**Heartly House, Inc.**'s Sexual Assault Rape Crisis Program provides a 24-hour hotline, medical accompaniment, crisis intervention and advocacy, individual and group counseling, and referrals to victims of sexual assault and their families throughout Frederick County. Additionally, they provide community education and outreach services regarding the prevention and treatment of rape and other sexual offenses.

Heartly House, Inc. has community partners throughout Frederick County including the Frederick Memorial Hospital. During Sexual Assault Awareness Month in April 2015, staff from Heartly House, Inc. worked with Frederick Memorial Hospital's Lead Forensic Nurse to set up various activities on the observance of Sexual Assault Awareness Month locally, which included a new awareness project "The Power of You: The Healing Process." Collectively, local schools, domestic violence/sexual assault centers, and others in the community assembled 100 after-care kits for victims of rape and sexual assault. These kits will be used by hospital staff, the Child Advocacy Center, and Heartly House, Inc. to support and comfort victims.

During Fiscal Year 2015, Heartly House, Inc. conducted community outreach presentations to help raise awareness and provide education about issues surrounding sexual assault. Furthermore, Heartly House, Inc. worked closely with Frederick County Adult Detention Center to ensure that Sexual Assault Forensic Examiners and Detention Center staff were trained and prepared to respond to inmate sexual assault cases through the Sexual Assault Forensic Nurse Examiner program at Frederick Memorial Hospital.
