





The Justice Reinvestment Act (Senate Bill 1005, 2016 session) requires each county to report by March 31<sup>st</sup> of each year to report various information on inmates detained in their jails who are awaiting trial. The screenshot below shows the preliminary data gathering and analysis completed by the Governor's Office of Crime Control & Prevention through data collected from the local detention centers. It provides the number of pretrial inmates on January 1, 2017, their average length of stay, their reason for not securing release, their primary offense, and the status of the case.


Length of Stay Category



Reason for not Securing Release




Case Dispositions of Inmates Held in Pretrial Detention
